### INFER Workshop « Heterodox Economics »

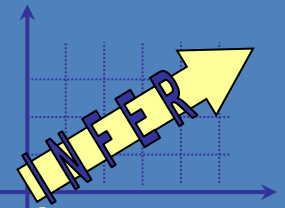
*Coimbra (Portugal), April 17<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup> 2015*
