Papers must be in English and must include an abstract of up to 500 words, 5 keywords, JEL classification and contact details for the corresponding author. Selected presenters are expected to discuss one other paper during the conference. As the conference intends to strengthen the INFER network, participation is welcome even without paper contribution.
