INFER Special Session Paper Submission Procedure

Full papers may be submitted to the INFER special session organizer, **Prof. Andreea Stoian, PhD** (andreea.stoian@fin.ase.ro) by **April 21, 2024**. Authors are allowed to submit only one paper to this special session. All submitted papers will be peer reviewed according to a high-quality and fast referee process. Authors will be notified whether their paper is accepted for presentation at the special session not later than **April 30, 2024**. Special session presenters are expected to discuss the papers during the session. The assignment of discussants will be made by the conference organizers at a later date.

The authors accepted at the INFER Special Session are also invited to submit their papers to special issues in: <u>Journal of Applied</u> <u>Economics</u> and <u>Eastern European Economics</u>.

Papers must be in English and must include a cover page with the following information:

- An abstract of up to 500 words, with JEL classification and no more than 5 keywords
- Authors' full name and affiliation
- Contact details for corresponding (e-mail)
